My Dear Loved Ones:

God says in Psalm 91:10 - "No evil shall befall you, / Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling."

This verse goes with the preceding verse (in the Young's paraphrase version :-)): "Since you've made the Most High LORD your refuge and dwelling place," God says that nothing of calamity will come upon us, nor any plague near us, except as God wills it. Being in the center of the will of God is the safest place to be. Absolutely nothing will come upon you personally except God wills it to happen. Being close with God is the safest place to be.

Let's face the music here in this verse. God says that the plague of the Covid-19 will not come near our dwelling (household) nor to us, except God wills it to happen. Your being invincible doesn't mean that you're presumptuous, though. We see this truth throughout this entire Psalm 91. We trust and depend upon God, but we exercise wisdom, but that trust demonstrates itself in reliance upon the LORD, not upon fear.

Loved ones, you may need to take this verse with you today and everyday as a promise from God Himself to protect you. Remind yourself of His promises or protection and provision for you.

Loved ones, we don't have to be afraid. If it's our time; it's our time. We trust God, but we aren't presumptuous.

Simply today: Take God at His Word. Claim this promise in prayer. Claim it as you go throughout the day.
